




# THE BAYOU ASSIGNMENT


Cut apart the assignments below. Place three different assignments in a bowl for each crew.




 Gator Guides, choose an action idea for traveling (like tiptoe). Then have your crew tiptoe to another crew and say, "Have a great day."


 Join hands around the Gator Games Leader, and then move in to give a group hug. Bayou Thank You-ers lead the crew in shouting "Thank you!"


 Sing "Happy Birthday" to the person whose birthday is the farthest away from today's date.


 Give high fives to someone in another crew.


 Give a back rub to a crew member for 10 seconds.


 Go to a Crew Leader and give a compliment, such as "You have a great smile" or "You are a fun leader."


 Shake hands with a person on another crew and say, "You made Crocodile Dock rock!"

 Go to another crew and tell them a joke. Schedule Supervisors, you can look on your daily schedule if your crew needs ideas.

 Gator Guides, choose an action idea for traveling (like hop). Then have your crew hop to another crew and shout, "Fear not!"

 Prayer People, lead your crew to another crew. Have your crew members bump knuckles with other crew members and say, "God cares for you."
